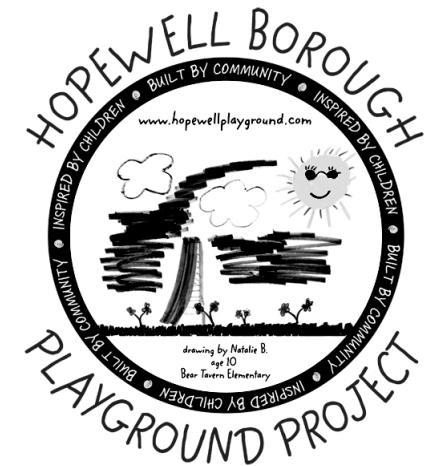

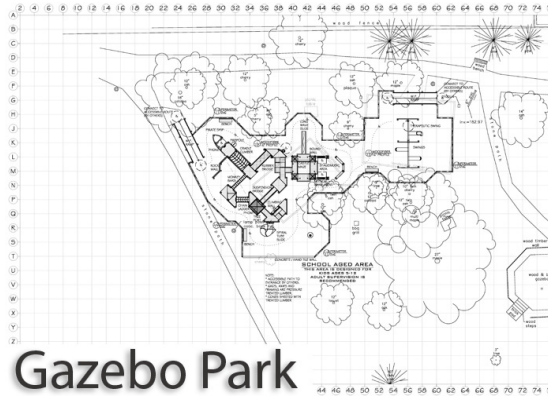

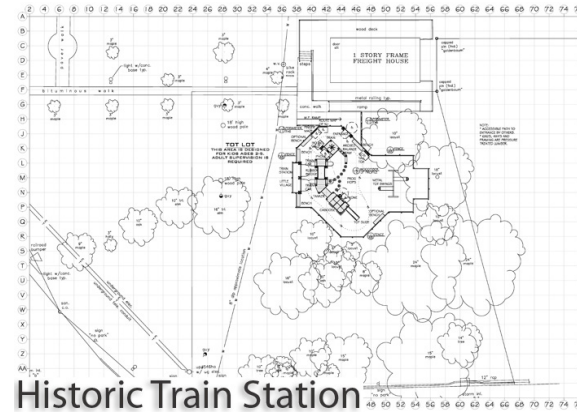
Gazebo Park

What does "community-built" mean?

A community-built playground is like an old-fashioned barn raising with volunteers of all ages working side-by-side to achieve a common goal. Together, we'll make strong friendships, feel an empowering sense of accomplishment, and help generate more "community" within our community.

What skills are required?

Anyone can participate—no construction skills required. Whether you are comfortable using power tools or not, there are many important tasks you can do.

What about quality?

During Build week, consultants from Leathers & Associates and volunteer construction captains will oversee quality as well as provide leadership and guidance to hundreds of volunteers.

How much will it cost?

When is Build week?

June 17-21, 2009 (rain or shine). Food and child-care will be provided. Daily construction schedule is divided into 3 1/2- to 4-hour long shifts, so you can come and go as needed.

How long will the playgrounds last?

The playgrounds can last 25 years, if properly maintained.
